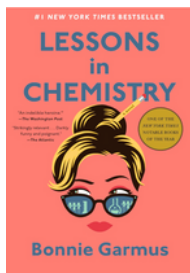

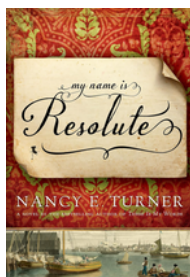

Lessons in Chemistry by Bonnie Garmus

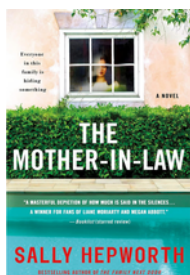

A twisty, compelling new novel about one woman's complicated relationship with her mother-in-law that ends in death...

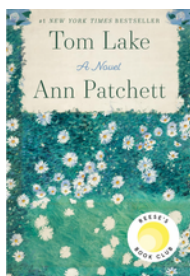

Jan. 22, 2026 Tom Lake by Ann Patchett

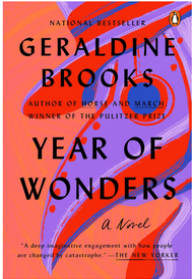
In this beautiful and moving novel about family, love, and growing up, Ann Patchett once again proves herself one of America's finest writers.

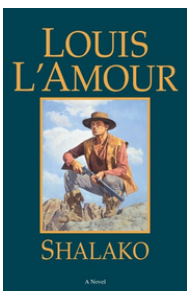
Apr. 23, 2026 We Never Asked for Wings by Vanessa Diffenbaugh

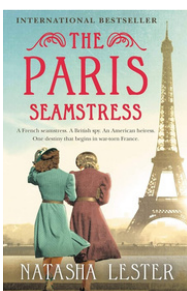
May 28, 2026 Flight Patterns by Karen White
